<b>Viura, Pasos de la Capula</b>	<b>Spain</b>	<b>Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>11.0%</b>	<b>£ 5.00</b>	<b>£ 7.00</b>	<b>£ 19.25</b>	<b>£ 27.00</b>
<i>Very expressive nose of gooseberry, apples and white flowers. Impressively rich, good acidity and fine balance on the palate.</i>							
<b>Pinot Grigio, Prima Alta, Veneto</b>	<b>Italy</b>	<b>Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>12.0%</b>	<b>£ 5.50</b>	<b>£ 7.50</b>	<b>£ 20.75</b>	<b>£ 29.00</b>
<i>A modern, clean Pinot Grigio with a pale straw colour and gently scented nose with acacia and white blossom flowers. The palate is dry, light to medium bodied with restrained peach and citrus fruit.</i>							
<b>Chardonnay Bella Storia, Cielo e Terra</b>	<b>Italy</b>	<b>Organic and Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>12.5%</b>	<b>£ 6.00</b>	<b>£ 8.25</b>	<b>£ 22.75</b>	<b>£ 32.00</b>
<i>Straw yellow in colour, with aromatics of white flowers and ripe peaches. The palate is soft and round, with a charming, delicate finish. This is excellent as an aperitif, and works well paired to soups, fish and poultry.</i>							
<b>Touraine Sauvignon Blanc Dom des Vaublins</b>	<b>France</b>		<b>12.5%</b>	<b>£ 6.50</b>	<b>£ 9.00</b>	<b>£ 25.00</b>	<b>£ 35.00</b>
<i>Complex nose with fine fruits notes (citrus, grapefruit) and minerals. On aeration, nice minerality with gunflint notes. The palate is rich and thick, but with extraordinary finesse. The fruits aromas are ripe and reminiscent of peach. This cuvée is powerful on the nose and on the palate, with great intensity and length.</i>							
<b>Picpoul de Pinet, Domaine de Cantagrils</b>	<b>France</b>	<b>Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>13.0%</b>	<b>£ 7.00</b>	<b>£ 9.75</b>	<b>£ 26.50</b>	<b>£ 37.00</b>
<i>The Domaine de Cantagrils Picpoul de Pinet is made from the uniquely Languedoc white grape, typified by sleek minerality and zippiness. A delicate golden colour in classic Picpoul style, the bouquet of the wine is composed of ripe exotic fruits, sweet spices and anise, and light, clean minerality.</i>							
<b>Albariño, Diluvio De Haan Altes</b>	<b>Spain</b>		<b>12.5%</b>				<b>£ 39.00</b>
<i>Delightfully refreshing and well balanced, the Diluvio Albarino from Bodegas Abanico in Rias Baixas has gorgeous nectarine and citrus fruits on the nose with a zippy palate and a hint of salinity on the finish.</i>							
<b>Sauvignon "BOB Short for Kate" Sauvignon Blanc</b>	<b>New Zealand</b>	<b>Organic and Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>12.5%</b>				<b>£ 42.00</b>
<i>This zesty Marlborough Sauvignon Blanc is made by Ben Glover one of the best wine makers in NZ today. Here he offers the best of what the region has to offer. Lashings of tropical passion fruit, guava and mandarin leap from the glass. Food friendly but equally drinks well on its own...</i>							
<b>Chardonnay, Cape Mentelle</b>	<b>Australia</b>	<b>Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>13.2%</b>				<b>£ 45.00</b>
<i>Brilliant pale lemon. The aromatics unfold with bright lemon zest and white blossom, and a mineral backbone. The palate is fresh and vibrant with a bright minerality and delicate biscuity texture. Succulent and salivating, opening up to frangipani, honeysuckle and lemon pie. Medium bodied with firm acidity and beautiful fruit purity, finishing with poise and clarity. All fruit is hand-picked and whole bunch pressed with 25% new French oak barriques.</i>							
<b>Pouilly Fume Les Loges Dom des Rabichatt</b>	<b>France</b>		<b>13.0%</b>				<b>£ 49.00</b>
<i>Founded in 1869, this estate is now in the safe hands of 6th generation brothers Fabrice and Vincent Grebet – although their father Gerard still keeps a close eye on proceedings. This traditional cuvée comes from a blend of around thirty plots from the Domaine, with clay-limestone and Kimmeridgian marl soils. Great minerality and citrus aromas characterise this absolute classic wine.</i>							
<b>Chablis, Domaine du Colombier</b>	<b>France</b>		<b>12.5%</b>				<b>£ 52.00</b>
<i>The Domaine du Colombier has been a family property (55 hectares) since 1887 and is now run by three sons, Jean-Louis, Thierry, and Vincent. This is an excellent source of pure, unoaked, mineral-laden Chablis. This is a perfect match for anything from the sea.</i>

<b>Pálido Rosé Lobetia, Dominio de Punctum 2022</b>	<b>Spain</b>	<b>Organic and Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>13.0%</b>	<b>£ 5.35</b>	<b>£ 7.50</b>	<b>£ 20.75</b>	<b>£ 29.00</b>
<i>Punctum Rosé is a glossy raspberry pink colour made from 100% Grenache. Red cherries, melon and strawberries on the nose, with those same characteristics shining through on the palate. An easy drinking organic rosé.</i>							
<b>Côtes de Provence Rose, Domaine Pinchinat</b>	<b>France</b>	<b>Organic</b>	<b>13.5%</b>	<b>£ 7.50</b>	<b>£ 10.50</b>	<b>£ 28.25</b>	<b>£ 39.50</b>
<i>This Côtes de Provence Rosé is a thoughtful blend of Grenache, Syrah, Cinsault, Rolle, Cabernet Sauvignon and Mourvèdre. Pale pink in colour and light in style, it is a classic Provence rosé to the core. Delicate hints of melon, peach and apricot on the nose are also present on the palate. The finish is persistent and fresh. An elegant example from a understated grower.</i>

<i>This red is so approachable, soft yet rich and ripe with deep concentration of soft berry fruit flavours and gentle tannins with a touch of spice, not unexpectedly a wine for all seasons. A very quaffable wine indeed.</i>							
<b>Primitivo, Terre Di Montelusa</b>	<b>Italy</b>	<b>Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>13.0%</b>	<b>£ 5.75</b>	<b>£ 7.75</b>	<b>£ 21.50</b>	<b>£ 30.00</b>
<i>This Primitivo from Terre di Montelusa is a dark, ruby-red with violet highlights. Intense and fragrant bouquet with a rich variety of sensations. Pleasant, harmonic and velvety taste.</i>							
<b>Malbec, Finca la Linda Bodega Luigi Bosca</b>	<b>Argentina</b>	<b>Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>13.5%</b>	<b>£ 6.25</b>	<b>£ 8.75</b>	<b>£ 24.25</b>	<b>£ 34.00</b>
<i>From Luján de Cuyo Commune, 15 kms south of Mendoza city, 960 m above sea-level, on the eastern slope of the foothills. Argentina's trademark grape variety, although originally known in South of France especially for 'Cahors'. Characteristically intense red colour and aromas of cherries, aged in French oak for 3 months. Great structure, fine and approachable, great with a steak.</i>							
<b>Pinot Noir Turitelles, Domaine d'Altugnac</b>	<b>France</b>	<b>Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>13.0%</b>	<b>£ 6.75</b>	<b>£ 9.50</b>	<b>£ 26.25</b>	<b>£ 36.50</b>
<i>This Pinot Noir Turitelles with garnet-coloured juice is perfumed with fine spices (nutmeg and cinnamon), mocha, and Montmorency cherry. Its texture finds its balance in a generous flavour that is felt in a velvety tannin highlighting the finesse of the grape variety.</i>							
<b>Côtes-du-Rhône Réserve, Domaine Grand Veneur</b>	<b>France</b>	<b>Organic</b>	<b>14.5%</b>	<b>£ 7.50</b>	<b>£ 10.50</b>	<b>£ 28.25</b>	<b>£ 39.50</b>
<i>A blend of Grenache Noir, Syrah, Cinsault and Mourvèdre. The colour is purple-tinged garnet. The aromatic range of the nose goes from fresh berries - wild raspberry, blackcurrant, blackberry - to spices. The palate is big and full flavoured, with silky tannins and aromas of the fruit already mentioned. The finish introduces touches of liquorice and pepper.</i>							
<b>Shiraz Heartland Estate</b>	<b>Australia</b>	<b>Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>14.5%</b>				<b>£ 42.00</b>
<i>The Heartland Shiraz is deep ruby colour, predicts aromas of black currants and smokehouse bacon. These notes are accompanied on the palate by dark chocolate and a wisp of pepper spice. The power and intensity of the wine is undeniable and well beyond expectation.</i>							
<b>Rioja Reserva Finca Nueva</b>	<b>Spain</b>	<b>Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>14.0%</b>				<b>£ 48.00</b>
<i>Finca Nueva Reserva is a red wine from the D.O. Rioja made from 100% Tempranillo grapes. The harvest is manual and the wine ferments for 20 days. It is then aged for 24 months in French oak barrels from Allier. Finally it is bottled without being filtered or clarified. Sweetness to the fruit and great oak integration</i>							
<b>"The Whole Shebang" Cuvée XIII, Bedrock Wine Co NV</b>	<b>USA</b>		<b>14.0%</b>				<b>£ 50.00</b>
<i>The Whole Shebang is a Mediterranean style multi-vintage blend aged in a solera system (no new oak). Predominantly made from old-vine Zinfandel, the blend also includes Carignan, Petite Sirah, Mourvèdre, Alicante Bouschet, Grenache, Syrah and Barbera. The result is a very fresh, ripe and perfumed red at excellent value.</i>							
<b>Les Piliers de Maison Blanche, Montagne Saint-Émilion</b>	<b>France</b>	<b>Biodynamic and Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>14.0%</b>				<b>£ 52.00</b>
<i>Château Maison Blanche Les Piliers de Maison Blanche from Montagne-Saint-Émilion is a refined blend of Cabernet Franc and Merlot and it shows well with just a few years of maturity. Aromas of cassis and dark berry fruits lead to a rounded palate with supple blackberry and plum flavours and a delicate spice note.</i>							
<b>Crozes Hermitage La Certitude, Domaine François Villard</b>	<b>France</b>		<b>12.5%</b>				<b>£ 57.00</b>
<i>François Villard has firmly established himself as one of greatest winemakers in the Northern Rhône area. His wines are bright, poised, and vivacious. Full-bodied but soft and elegant with fine-grained tannins, lots of red berry and cherry fruit, pepper, spice and hints of oak from new barrels.</i>

Crisp and well balanced, it is the perfect aperitif, as well as a good match for fish and seafood.</i>							
<b>Cuvée Royale Brut, Champagne Joseph Perrier NV</b>	<b>France</b>	<b>Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>12.0%</b>				<b>£ 65.00</b>
<i>The true expression of the House style. Elegant, fresh, light, well-balanced with good length, this is the perfect celebration champagne. 35% Chardonnay, 35% Pinot Noir and 30% Pinot Meunier, with around 20% reserve.</i>							
<b>Cuvée Royale Rosé, Champagne Joseph Perrier NV</b>	<b>France</b>	<b>Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>12.0%</b>				<b>£ 70.00</b>
<i>This Rose has a strong character underpinned by a well-structured vinous centre, and delicious fruity character. As an aperitif it will transport you straight to a summer's day and it will partner a terrine of ham hock, or pink lamb, or even a dessert if it is not too sweet. A perfect partner for all things pink! 25% Chardonnay and 75% Pinot Noir and Pinot Meunier, of which around 12% is AOC</i>							
<b>Cuvée Royale Blanc De Blancs, Champagne Joseph Perrier NV</b>	<b>France</b>	<b>Vegan Friendly</b>	<b>12.0%</b>				<b>£ 75.00</b>
<i>For a special occasion this makes a notable aperitif, and with the fish course in particular. 100% Chardonnay, with approximately 15% of reserve wines. Aged for a minimum of 5 years.</i>
